The Ronald Reagan Institute of Emergency Medicine at The George Washington University Medical Center (USA) has collaborated with partners in India to implement Master's in Emergency Medicine (International) training program. The programs consist of a three year curriculum that will be divided into 36 clinical modules that will cover the breadth of emergency medicine. Faculty from the Reagan Institute travel periodically to the training centers to provide direct supervision and teaching. At the successful conclusion of the program, the graduating residents will be certified to work within the emergency department of small and large hospitals.
